Bowker Creek is making it to the big screen.

Volunteers with the Bowker Creek Initiative Outreach and The Friends of Bowker Creek are making a video about the waterway to help teach people about its history.

"We are interested in really the long term health of Bowker Creek, in terms both of it as a stream but also it as a way of handling storm water," said volunteer Gerald Harris.

The documentary will look at the current state of the creek as well as it's future. But in order to really understand what's going on, the group needs to know what it used to be like. And that's where the public comes in, Harris said.

"Anybody who is alive today was aware of the creek when it was already significantly degraded," Harris said, noting they may remember when there were fish in it.
